



Photos and the Internet



To keep photos private: only share digital pictures on a site that requires a password to see photos, or only allows people access by invitation.

Skip Captions on Photo Sharing Websites

- Avoid putting captions on photos that include identifying information such as full names, addresses, birthdays, locations, PIN numbers, account numbers, or social security numbers.

Remember that Photo Share Websites are Public

- Never write information on a photo sharing site that would be uncomfortable to tell a complete stranger. When someone writes a caption on a photo, they are writing it for the entire world to see.
- Never include anything in captions like "we're so excited to go to Aruba this weekend," "here's a beautiful shot of our \$3,000 stereo system," or "looking forward to a quiet evening alone tonight." Captions like these open people up to becoming victims of theft or worse. Photo share users should never write anything that could potentially be used against them by a thief.

Photo Share Websites can be viewed by Internet Pedophiles

- Do not include private information such as your name with your picture.
- Do not talk about your school, friends, age or favorite things.

Remember all information posted publically online may be read by ANYONE!
